present. Minutes of the previous meeting read &
approved. Mr. M. Wallis notified the Faculty that
his daughter would not be able to continue on account
of poor health. The adoption of the following res-
olution was moved - Resolved -
That on and after June 1889 the Commencement
exercise of each student shall be determined
by his or her standing in our College Courses.
When the average standing is from 96 to 100 such
as above, the Commencement Exercise shall be a Philo-
sophical Oration;
When the standing from 90 to less than 96, the
exercise shall be a High Oration;
When the standing is from 80 to less than 90,
the exercise shall be a First Class Oration;
When the standing is from 70 to less than 80,
it shall be a Second Class Oration;
When the standing is less than 70, the student
shall not make a commencement speech or address
of any kind.

Resolved that the above resolution be published in our
annual Catalogues.
On motion, the above resolution was laid on the table
until the next regular meeting of the Faculty.*
On motion, the Faculty adjourned.

all present, minutes of the previous meeting

read and approved. It was moved that Porter be informed that The Faculty deems it inexpedient to allow him to engage in public lectures and Theatricals during Christmas vacation. Carried. Messrs Finley and Hayes asked permission to drop Sherman at the end of this term. Their petition was granted with the understanding that they must do good work up to the end of this term, and take three (3) studies next term. The excuses of Chas. Miller, Burl, J. McRay & Geo. Finley for not having returned to school Saturday Nov 2nd were accepted. On motion, the Resolution in reference to Commencement Exercises was taken from the table. On motion, the Resolution was adopted. It was moved that 100 be taken as a standard in making daily recitations. Carried. Mr. Hindman having remained from the University without permission, his case was referred to the President with power to act. The following resolution was unanimously adopted - Whereas - Mr. Clyde Patterson is making very little progress in his studies, and will not be able to continue them with his present classes during the ensuing term, therefore - Resolved that his father be informed of these facts and advised either to withdraw him from The University, or to permit him to go on as an irregular student. On motion, the Faculty adjourned.
