Managing Director The Resource Innovation Group and Climate Leadership Initiative Eugene, Oregon

The Resource Innovation Group (TRIG), a 501 (c)(3) non-profit affiliated with the Institute for a Sustainable Environment at the University of Oregon, seeks a Managing Director.

Global climate change requires innovative solutions to decarbonize society while also helping society prepare for the impacts of global warming that cannot be avoided. TRIG, which includes the Climate Leadership Initiative (CLI), assists federal, state, and local governments, non-profits and private businesses to design, implement, and evaluate strategies and policies to achieve these ends. Programs include Climate Preparation, Climate Economics, Community Energy, Climate Communications and Behavioral Change, and Climate Equity. Primary Duties: Manage all internal aspects of the TRIG and CLI operations. The Managing Director will also actively participate in one or more of the organization's programs.

Specific Responsibilities

1. Oversee and manage all organizational program development, delivery and evaluation.
2. Oversee and manage organizational fundraising including grants, contracts, and donor development as well as project evaluation and report writing.
3. Supervise and coordinate staff as well as UO GTFs and student interns.
4. Support and work with the TRIG board of directors, UO faculty, and organizational partners on projects.
5. Approximately 50 percent of time will involve active engagement in one or more of the organization's programs.
6. Support other organizational needs as identified by the Executive Director.
7. Report to and work closely with the Executive Director in all phases of the job.

This is not a state funded position. It is a grant-funded position with a non-profit organization affiliated with the UO. Continued employment will depend on the ability of the Managing Director to raise sufficient funds.

Qualifications:

- Entrepreneurial mindset and demonstrated ability to establish and fund innovative solutions to complex problems.
- Successful fundraising experience with foundation, government, private or other funding sources.
- Successful experience in program development and managing professional staff and teams.
- Demonstrated strong organizational administration background and skills.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Ability to work cooperatively with diverse people, including university, government, business, foundation, non-profit, and rural, urban and minority community representatives.
- Background in sustainable natural resource management, business development, renewable energy, communications, or climate mitigation or preparation (adaptation), behavioral or organizational change management preferred.
- Advanced degree in the social or biophysical sciences required.

Location: The position will be located in Eugene, Oregon.
