Screening of applications will take place as positions become available and continue until positions are filled. The first screening will begin after April 3. Candidates with a Ph.D. are preferred but candidates with a Master's degree or who have advanced to candidacy in a Ph.D. program will also be considered.

Complete applications must include: a statement of interest describing qualifications, a curriculum vitae, proposed syllabus, a brief writing sample and at least two letters of recommendation.
