Requirements and Application**

If you're interested in applying for the Graduate Teaching Fellowship with the Eugene Symphony, supply four (4) copies of an audio recording containing the repertoire noted below. These will be submitted to the Eugene Symphony Orchestra (ESO) for review. This recording is specifically for the ESO GTF and must be submitted in order to be considered.

**Note:** The ESO GTF is not always available. Please consult a faculty member in your instrument area for a list of current GTF openings.
