**Important Information from the Director of Graduate Studies
for Graduate International Applicants**

Thank you for your interest in the University of Oregon School of Music and Dance. In addition to the other admissions application procedures, international applicants are also responsible for the following:

English Language Proficiency Requirement. Applicants whose native language is not English must show proof of language proficiency through one of the following three methods:

1. Submit an acceptable score from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) examination.
2. Submit an acceptable score from the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) examination.
3. Submit degree transcripts proving that you have received a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited U.S. institution or from an institution in the following countries: Australia, Canada (excluding Quebec), Ireland, New Zealand, or the United Kingdom.

Acceptable TOEFL or IELTS scores for music graduate admission:

IELTS	7.0	7.0

Visa Status. Most international students attending the University of Oregon hold a student (F-1) visa. To obtain a student visa, the form I-20 must be presented to a U.S. consul. U.S. Government regulations require that the University of Oregon verify the availability of sufficient financial support for non-immigrant students before a Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20) can be issued. International students must submit financial documents (e.g., Graduate Teaching Fellowship (GTF) appointment contract, scholarship award letter) and/or bank statements with their applications. International students will receive a Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20) after admission to the UO.

Health Insurance. The University of Oregon requires that all international students and their families be covered by university-approved health and accident insurance.
