Policies

Homework: We will be using WebAssign this term. See the other side of this paper for instructions on logging in. Be sure to let me know (by email or in class) of any problems you are having with WebAssign. Generally there will be one homework assignments due every week. I encourage you to work with others on homework as long as you are able to do all of the problems on your own.

Quizzes: There will be a quiz almost every week (usually on Friday). Quizzes will be at the end of class (usually 15-20 minutes). *There are no make-up quizzes*, but I will drop your lowest quiz score. Quizzes will consist of several questions of varying difficulty. You will NOT be allowed to use your calculator for quizzes.

Exams: There will be two midterm exams given during class time, and a final exam. *There are no make-up exams*. Make arrangements with me *prior* to the exam if you believe you have a legitimate reason to reschedule. You will NOT be allowed to use your calculator for exams.

Attendance: I expect you to attend each class session promptly. Although I do not grade attendance or tardiness directly you are responsible for all information announced in class, in addition to the new material covered. In short, regular attendance is required for success in this course. If you absolutely must miss class, email me before class to find out any new homework assignments, and get the notes from a classmate afterwards.

Grading: Letter grades in this course will correspond approximately with the following scale:

Your grade will be computed as follows:

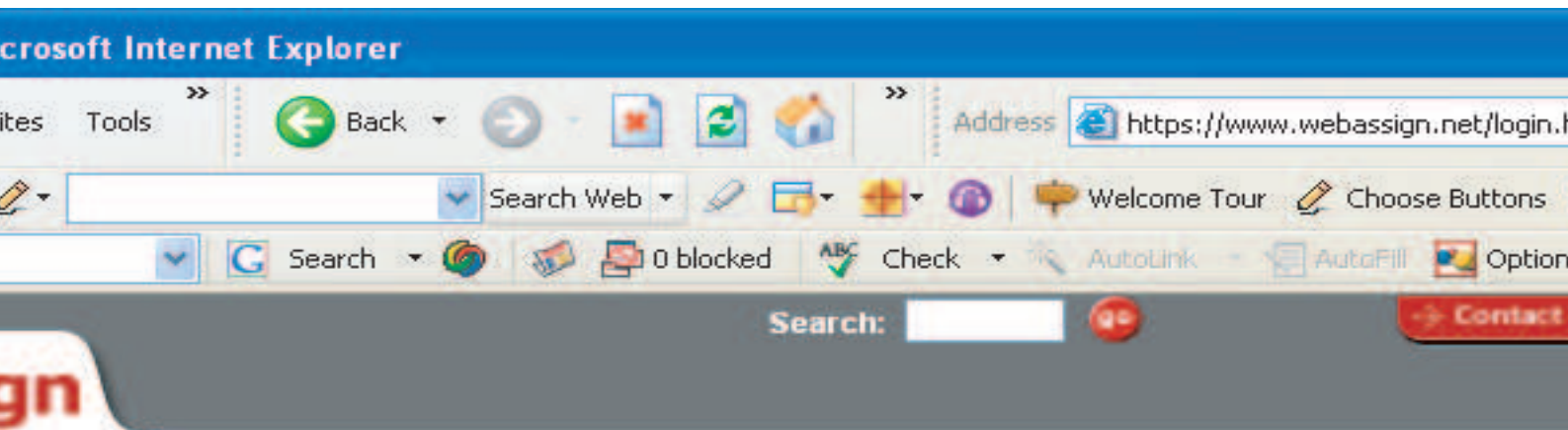
Homework (15%), Quizzes (15%), Midterms (20% each), Final Exam (30%).
