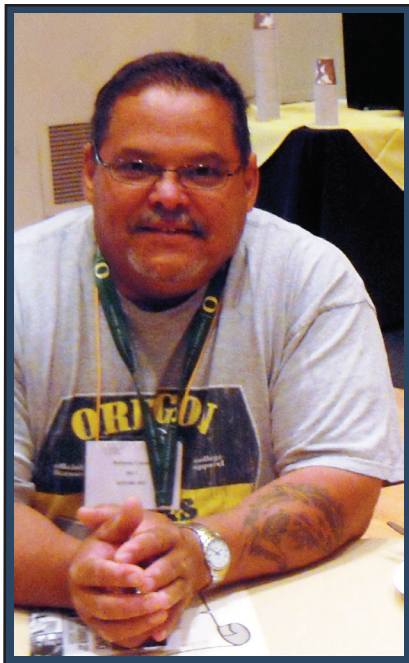

The past year has seen unprecedented attacks on unions and workers' rights in both the public and private sector. Elected officials at both the state and federal levels have set to work restricting collective bargaining rights, cutting wages and benefits, undermining standards in the construction industry, and more broadly trying to make it harder for working people to effectively organize. And all this is happening in a time of economic crisis, when unions may be more needed than ever before. This class will examine the past year, understand who is behind the attacks, help think about what the future may bring here in Oregon, and help strategize about what role union members can play in strengthening the position of working people within the state.
