PLAN AHEAD

Every spring, close to 3000 students move out of the residence halls in a few days. Make it easy on yourself and the staff. Start cleaning early instead of throwing it all away.

Here's what you can do with your recyclable and reusable materials:

DONATING REUSABLE ITEMS

From May 31 until June 9, you'll have a convenient way to lighten your load and help the community. Donate reusable items by placing them in collection containers in the common areas of all residence halls. Collected items will benefit the Springfield-Marcola Family Resource Center.

- University Inn.....Laundry Rooms
- Riley.....1st Floor Kitchen Area

PAPER

All recycling sites collect either mixed or sorted white and colored/low-grade paper. Includes computer paper, notebooks, magazines, junkmail, paper bags, cereal boxes, wrapping paper and stationery.

Materials accepted are glass, metals and plastic tubs/jugs/jars/bottles.

NEWSPAPER

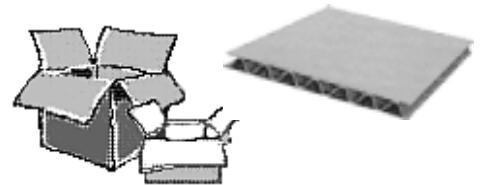
Daily newspapers and inserts only. Newspaper recycling is located at or near all recycling sites.



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard is two pieces of paper separated by a wavy middle layer.

PLEASE FLATTEN!
