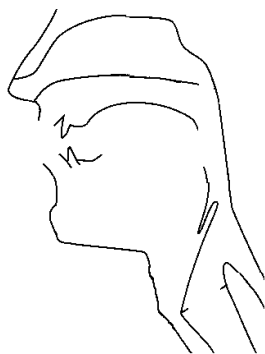

Part I: Midterm Questions

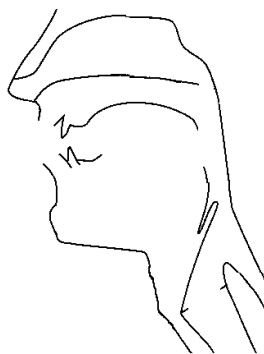

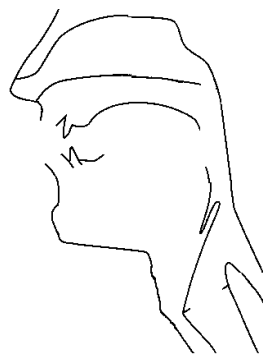
1. Complete the Sammy diagram and give the phonetic symbol for each of the following English consonants:



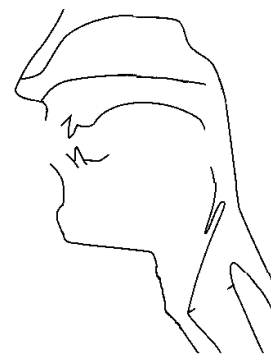

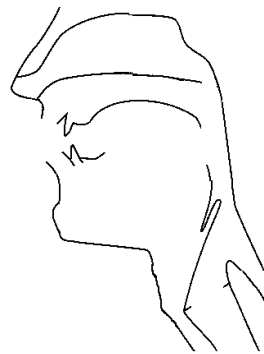
2. Complete the Sammy diagram and give the minimal description of each of the following English consonants (i.e., do not mention redundant features – this means some of the blank lines will remain blank):



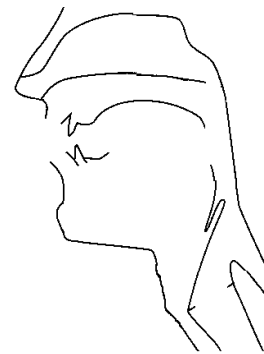
