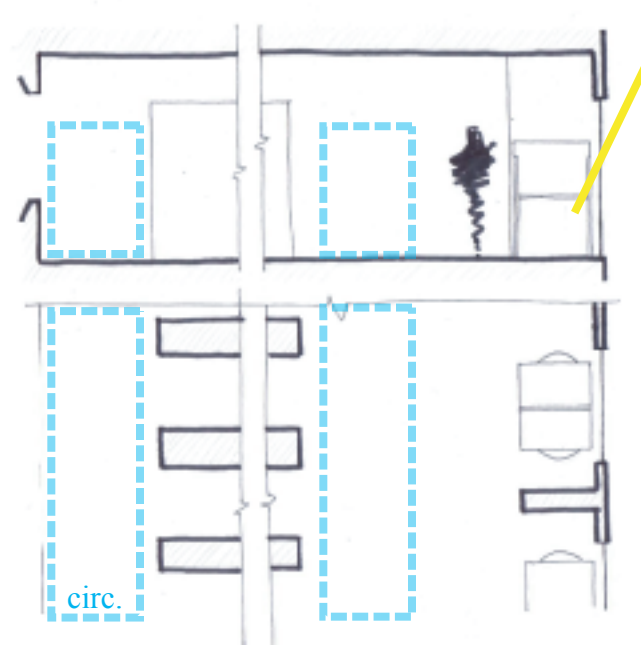

daylighting (from directly above and side)

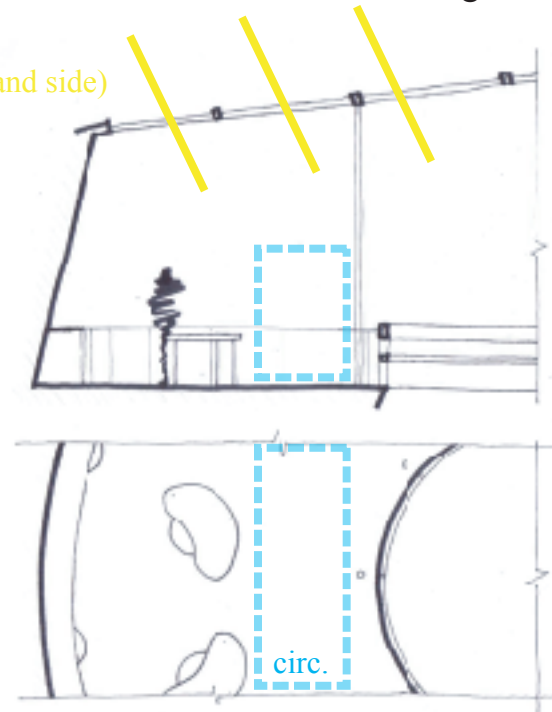
